Criteria and Application Form for Applying for Grants 2019

Criteria

Each year Party in the Park will allocate a proportion of its funds to worthy causes. To apply for a grant organisations must fulfil the following two criteria.

- The organisation and/or its beneficiaries must be based in Peasedown St John
- The applicant must be a registered charitable trust or a 'Not For Profit' organisation

Organisations that qualify to apply should be able to show how their project fulfils most of the following guidelines. The applicant should:-

- Include the mission statement of the organisation and web address if possible.
- Provide a clear definition of the project for which the funds are required.
- Ideally show that the project is on-going and sustainable rather than a 'one-off'
- Provide evidence of other funding sources and fundraising for their project.
- Provide evidence of the benefit to the community
- Use any funds granted only for the project described in the application form.

It is unlikely that funds will be available for capital projects such as building works. Applications are more likely to succeed if they aim to support people, training, skills and activities. Preference will be given to people/groups who have not applied in previous years

With the applicants permission we would like to be able to use reports about their project in any future publicity to do with fundraising for Party in the Park. If possible we would like a representative to attend a presentation at Party in the Park 2019 on Sat 08 June 2019

Application Process

Applications are invited from organisations during the months of February and March 2019 with a closing date of Friday 22nd March 2019. Applications will be considered during April and applicants will be informed of the outcomes by the end of that month.
